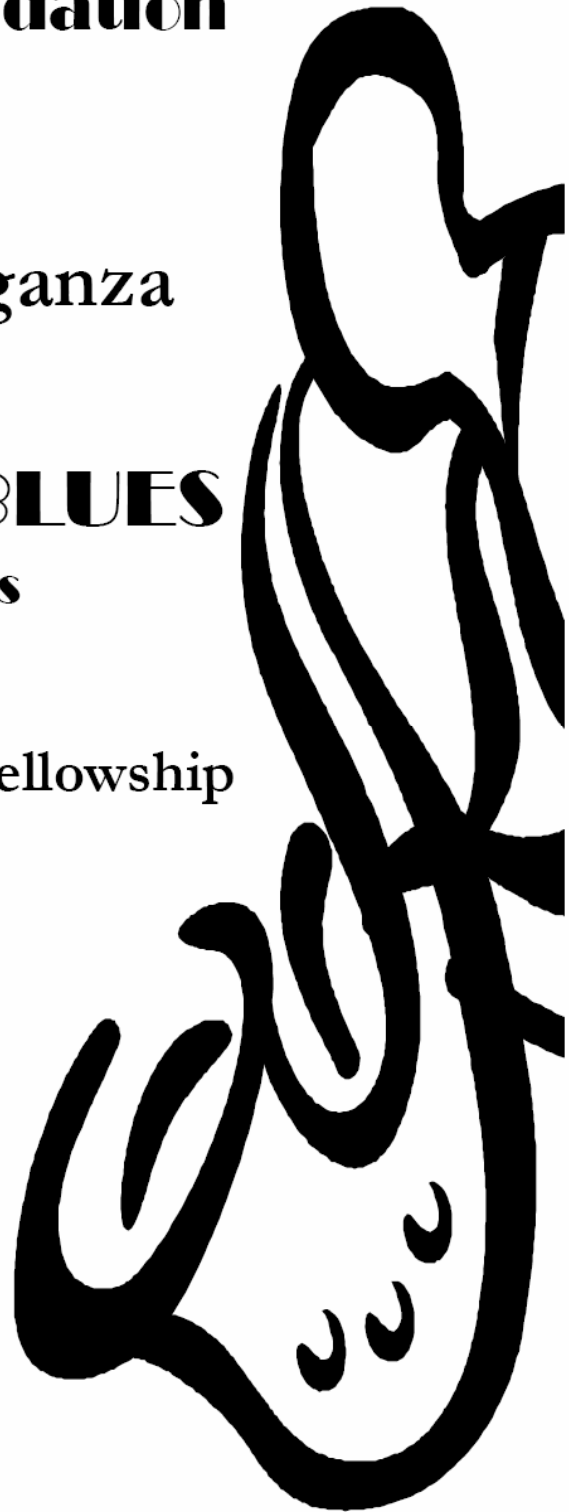

Berkeley Law Foundation

The Berkeley Law Foundation was **founded by Boalt students** in 1976 and was **the nation's first student-run** public interest law foundation.

Our mission is to fund public interest law projects that serve disadvantaged people. BLF members invest directly in the public work of our peers, structurally emphasizing a **shared-income approach to social change**. We make this choice because we recognize that lawyers have a personal and professional responsibility to dismantle systemic inequalities and to improve access to justice. Recognizing that this responsibility applies equally to the structure of our own law school community, the members of BLF incorporate **diversity as a core value**.

Our approach to funding public interest law empowers legal practitioners to pursue careers in the public interest, launches creative public interest projects and organizations, provides legal services to thousands of disadvantaged people, and deploys the power of the law in the service of social justice.

The Phoenix Fellowship

In November 1996, California voters passed Proposition 209, an initiative that ended affirmative action programs in state-sponsored or state-funded education, employment, and contracting. Proposition 209 had the effect of threatening the ability of public schools to attract and recruit students of color. This is of particular concern to the Boalt Hall, which has had a long-standing commitment to diversity. Hence, the Berkeley Law Foundation responded by establishing the Phoenix Fellowship.

The goal of the Phoenix Fellowship is two-fold: (1) to encourage students of color to apply to Boalt; and (2) to support a commitment to doing public interest work among these students. To fulfill these goals, the Phoenix Fellowship guarantees funding to students of color committed to providing direct legal services to underrepresented communities. This funding provides the Fellow with the opportunity to secure the summer job placement of his or her choice without being constrained by the host organization's ability to provide a salary. The Fellowship is administered entirely by Boalt students.

In 1998, the National Association of Public Interest Law (NAPIL) awarded the Berkeley Law Foundation a prestigious national commendation for its creation and administration of this crucial and unique mechanism for student recruitment and ongoing support at the country's leading public law school.

Silent Auction

- Silent auction begins at 8:00 p.m. sharp!
- Locate your item in the program and proceed to the corresponding table. Each will have a bid sheet listing the item description, the minimum bid, and the minimum raise. Each bid must raise the previous bid by at least the amount given on the sheet.
- Submit your bid by providing your name, email address, and phone number on the bid sheet. If your name or other information is illegible, the item will be awarded to the next highest bidder.
- There are a number of items (especially those donated by faculty) being offered to more than one winner. Please note that for these items, the top two or three (or more, where applicable) bidders will win the item. Where relevant, this will be in the item description and on the bid sheet.
- Announcements will be made ten minutes and five minutes before each table closes
- Once a table closes, no further bidding will be allowed. Any bids recorded after the table closes will not be counted.
- Winners of each item will be posted immediately after the close of the table.
- Items will be available for pick-up thirty minutes after the close of the table.
- Before you leave, please pay for your item at the Check-Out Stations.
